| | 769 | Prescribing or dispensing controlled to new patient – MAPS report. Exempt: ER, Hospice, Oncology. Take effect Jan 2019 | Health Policy committee |
| | 770 | Add order for remedial education on addiction and additional action for those found in violation of dispensing laws. Take effect Jan 2019 | Health Policy committee |
| 5378 | 805 | Adding dispensing of opioid antagonist to schools. | Passed Senate Oct 2016 House bill referred to Health Policy |
| | 1024 | Requires veterinarians, pharmacists to use MAPS when dispensing. | Health Policy Committee |
| 5326 | | Requires veterinarians, pharmacists to use MAPS when dispensing. Exempts opioid antagonist Rx and hold harmless. | Passed by House May 2016 |
| | 828 | Requires veterinarians, pharmacists to use MAPS when dispensing. Exempts ER and opioid antagonist Rx | Health Policy committee |
| | 778 | Specifically allows pharmacists to dispense opioid antagonist and hold harmless. | Passed by Senate June 2016 |
| 5649 5650 | | Hold harmless drug possession if seeking medical treatment <u>Any age</u> | Took effect July 2016. |
| 5587 | | Hold pharmacist harmless if refuse to fill Rx (senate would like to add consult physician before refusal) | Passed by house May 2016 |
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
